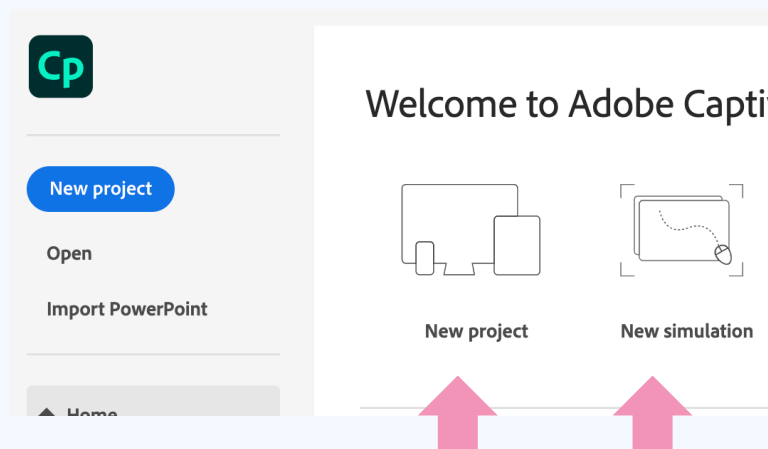

IN YOUR CLASSROOM

Make sure before you begin that technology is integral to what you want to accomplish, and not just a gimmick!



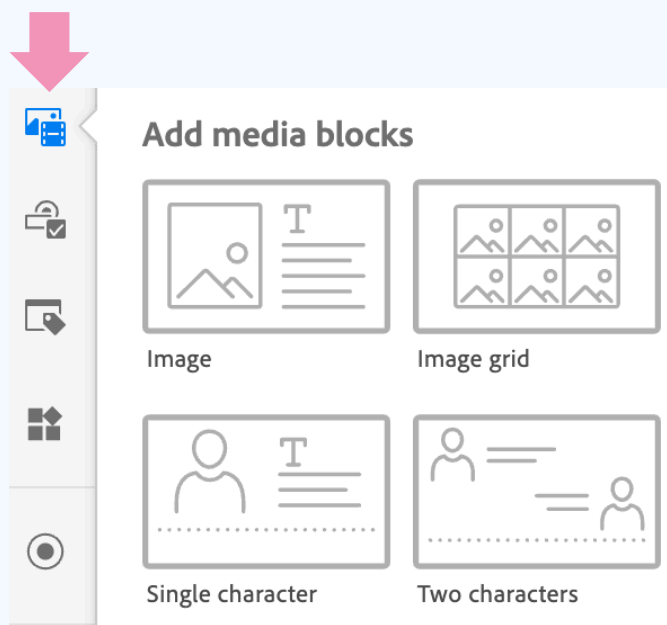
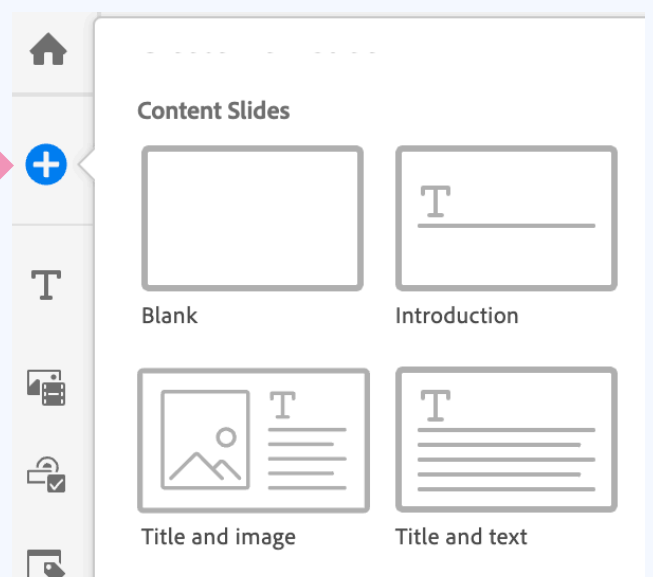
SELECT YOUR PROJECT

Select “**new project**” for a customizable slide deck; select “**new simulation**” for a screen recording.

This guide starts with projects.

START WITH SLIDES

Use the **circle button with a plus** to select a **slide type**. **Four** of the types are pictured at left, **remaining types are:** comparison, meet the team, character and text, and conversation

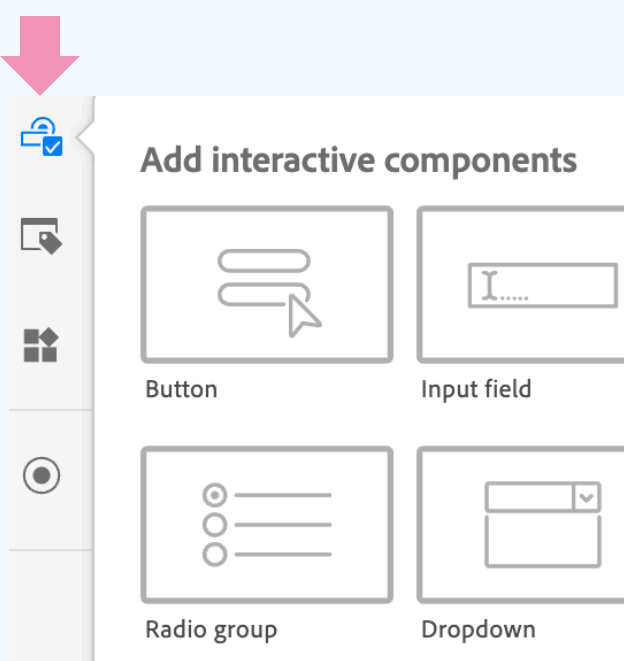
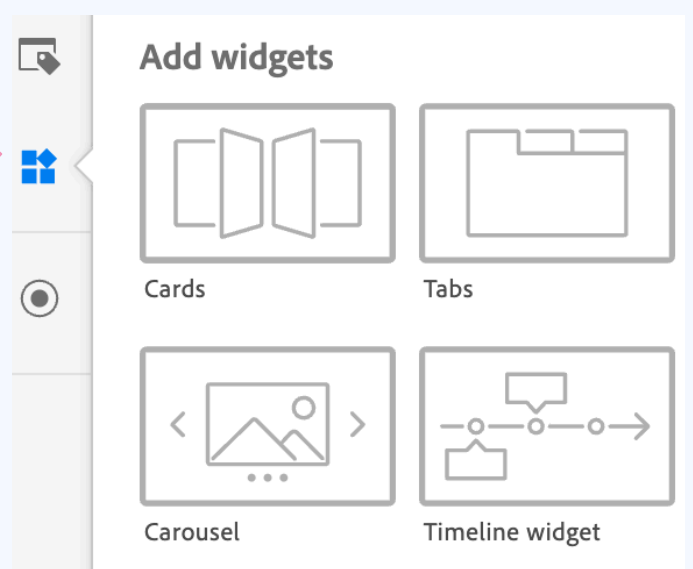


ADDING MEDIA BLOCKS

Media blocks allow you to easily import additional media such as images or videos. They also allow you to make use of Captivate’s avatar features.

AD WIDGETS

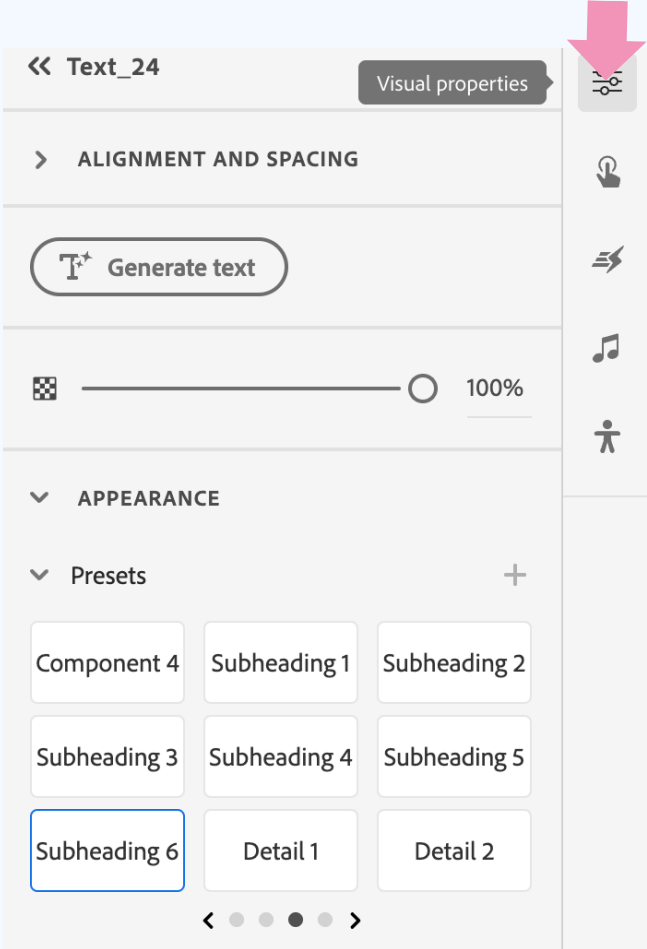
Widgets **add interactivity** to your slides. This allows you to control how content is shown and keep slides clean. Additionally, it allows students to control how they move through the information.



INTERACTIVE COMPONENTS

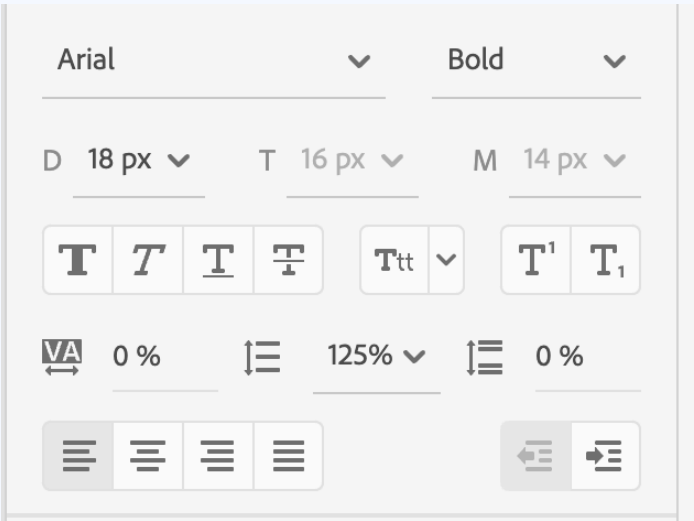
Interactive components allow you to check students’ knowledge and for students to deepen their learning.

CUSTOMIZATION



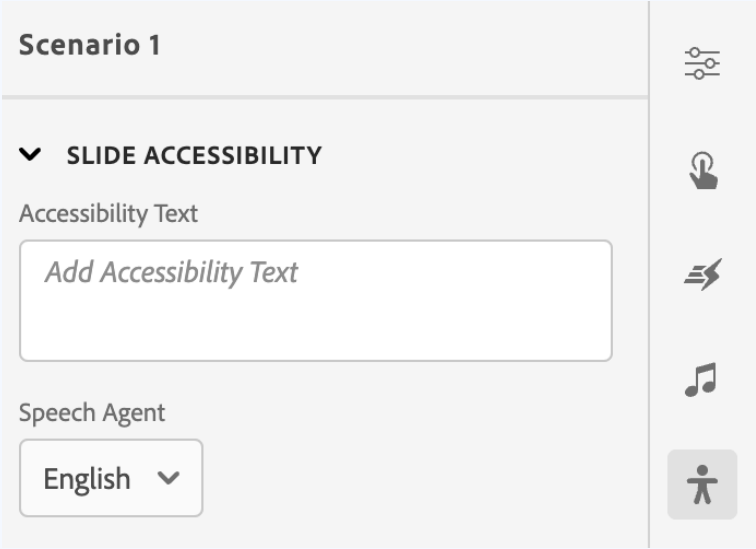
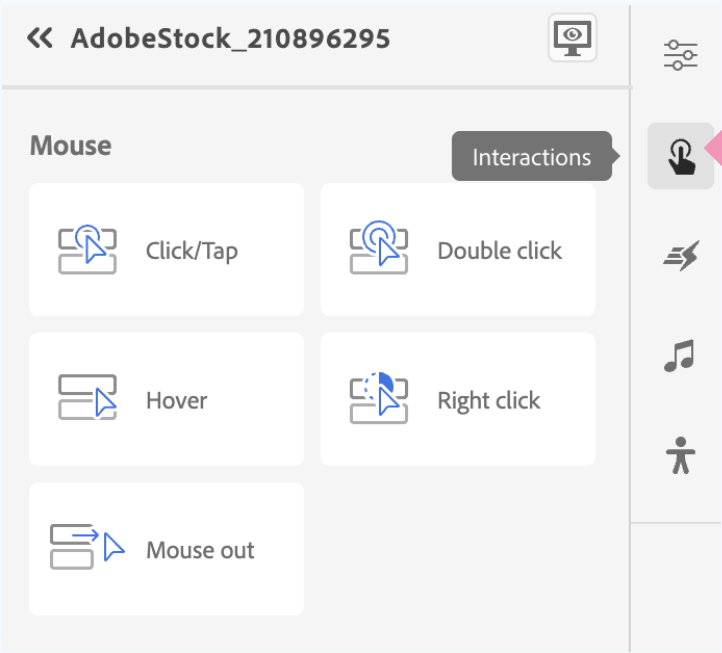
VISUAL PROPERTIES

Visual properties allows you to customize nearly all aspects of the slides such as: slide appearance, images, text, and number of widgets.



INTERACTIONS

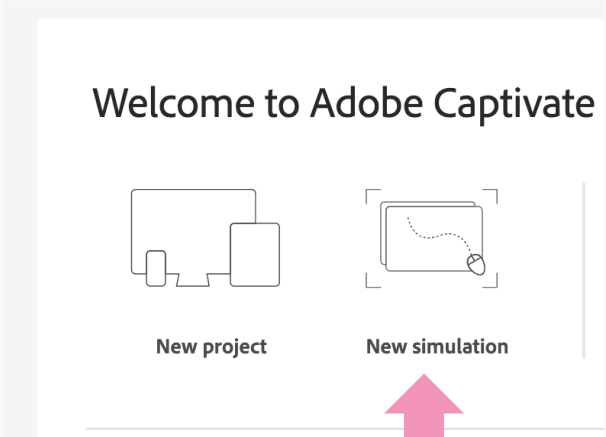
Interactions on the right side allow you to link elements from slide to slide to allow for more customization.



ACCESSIBILITY

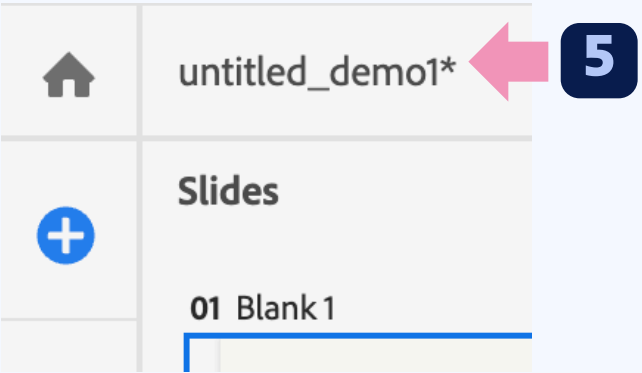
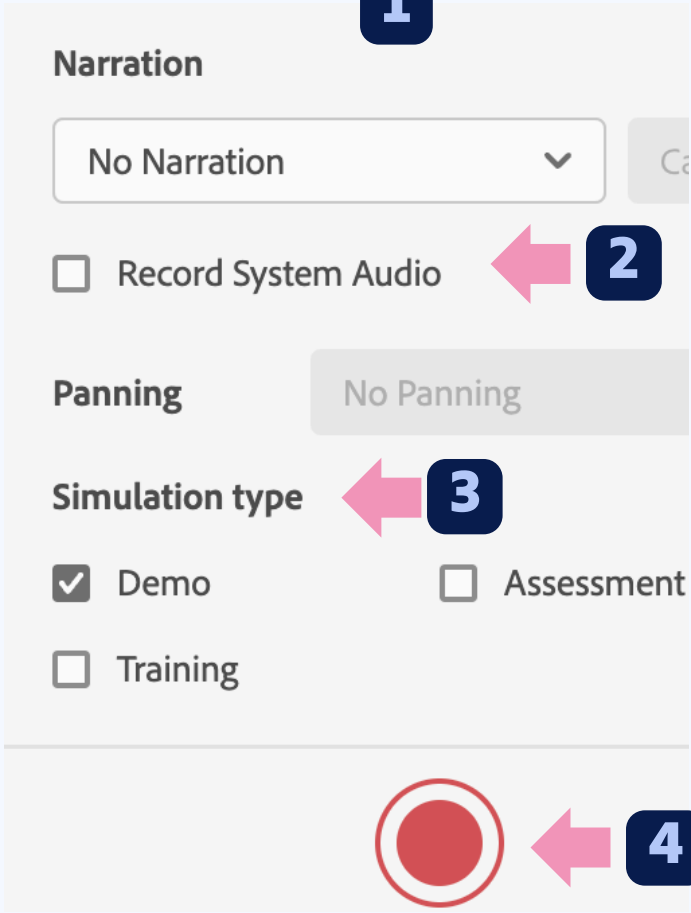
Adobe captivate makes it easy to add accessibility measures.

SCREEN RECORDING



QUICK TUTORIAL

1. Select Simulation
 - a. ensure your system has proper sharing permissions on
2. Choose audio input type
3. Choose simulation type
4. Click Record
5. When done recording, Captivate will open up a demo, allowing you to edit and add material as needed
